Rules for your visit to Eltz Castle



Dear visitors,

Castles, like Eltz Castle, are our heritage and important witnesses of our past. In order to allow access for everyone and to preserve this heritage for future generations, we require you to adhere to the following rules when visiting the castle:

- Please respect the tranquillity of the nature and avoid excessive noise in order not to disturb others.
- ❖ Do not enter any fenced off areas or climb on rocks, walls, towers or barriers.
- ❖ Be aware that surfaces can be slippery inside and outside when it rains.
- ❖ It is not permitted to eat or drink inside the museum rooms of the castle.
- It is strictly forbidden to touch any of the exhibits.
- ❖ Backpacks and child carriers cannot be taken inside the museum. Please leave these in the office.
- ❖ All parents are responsible for their children and must make sure that they adhere to the rules.
- ❖ Please follow all staff instructions. Failure to do so can result in you being asked to leave the premises. Your entrance fee will not be reimbursed.

Our advice: the guided castle tour is recommended only for children from preschool age.
